RE: Donation of One Acre-Foot of Reusable Water

Dear Mr. Sheldon,

Upon meeting with you, Arapahoe County Water and Wastewater Authority (ACWWA) has agreed to provide Parker Jordan Metropolitan District (PJMD) one (1) acre-foot of fully reusable water during the months of February and March 2012. It is our understanding that this water will be used to offset depletions to Cherry Creek as a result of land application of water pumped through dewatering sumps for both the Cherry Creek Stream Reclamation at Parker Jordan Centennial Open Space and Cherry Creek Low Water Crossing South of Arapahoe Road projects currently under construction.

The fully consumable water will be released from the Lone Tree Water Reuse Facility into Cherry Creek as part of our normal discharge operations. ACWWA will allocate one (1) acre-foot of water to PJMD from its releases on or about March 25, 2012. ACWWA will account for this allocation on the accounting forms it provides to the State on a monthly basis. A copy of the submitted accounting showing the release can be provided to PJMD upon request.
