- non-profit organizations that are classified as 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(13) organizations
- For-profit organizations
- Organizations having 100 or fewer employees
- All applicants must be licensed and registered to conduct business in the State of Colorado and in good standing with the Colorado Secretary of State



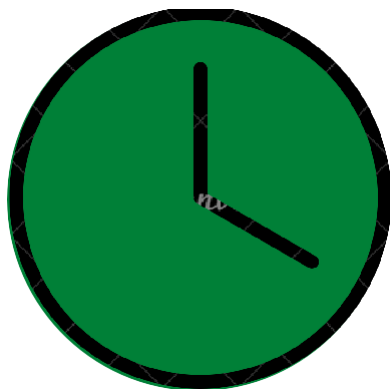
## APPLICATION GUIDELINES
